- This grant is available to students that have resided in the parishes of Stoke Mandeville or Great or Little Hampden for 2 or more years as at 1 September 2023.
- This grant is only available to students continuing in further education at college or university following completion of their compulsory secondary school examinations.
- Applications from students studying at secondary school for GCSE's, AS and A-levels, or equivalent exams **will not** be considered under this application process. If you require assistance with educational costs due to hardship, assistance with school trips or assistance with the purchase costs of uniform or educational equipment please contact the administrator separately at smandopc@gmail.com
- This grant is intended to assist with the costs of purchasing books and equipment necessary to continuing studies in further education and will not be sufficient to cover tuition fees or maintenance.
- This grant is considered by the Trustees for renewal annually and is granted at their discretion. The amount of the grant will therefore vary year on year. Be aware that the grant could be reduced or even discontinued at any time. Therefore, it should not be relied upon when forming a decision as to whether or not to attend a college or university course
- This application should be submitted to the address on the top of this form, and should be accompanied by confirmation from your college or university that you will be attending for the academic year 2023-2024. **DO NOT SUBMIT YOUR FORM WITHOUT THE RELEVANT CONFIRMATION DOCUMENTS.**

IMPORTANT NOTE: THE 2023-2024 APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants meeting the required eligibility criteria, who have provided a legible application form completed and correct, and who have included appropriate supporting documentation, will receive their grant as soon as their application has been processed.
- Grants will be issued as one instalment of £350 per student for university students or one instalment of £250 for college & “other” students.
- This grant will close to new applicants for the academic year 2023-2024 at midnight on 31 December 2023. Applications for studies during this academic year submitted after this deadline will not be considered.
- The Charity is NOT able to confirm receipt of your application due to sheer volume. Please allow at least one month from date of posting before contacting the Charity with regard to the progress of your application.
- The Charity office hours are Monday, 10am to 3pm and Friday, 10am to 12pm. The office will be closed for vacation between 25 May and 4 June and between 27 July and 4 September 2023. The office is not open on Bank Holidays.

What proof of attendance can I send?

You are required to send documentation that confirms your attendance specifically for the academic year you are applying for. **Application forms without this confirmation will be rejected.**

You may send a letter or email from UCAS or your university or college that indicates you are registered or confirms that you are going to be on the course.

If no letter of confirmation from your college or university is automatically sent to you, you must ask your registrar, tutor or school administrator for one.

If you do not have appropriate confirmation before you begin university or college, PLEASE WAIT and ask the school for the correct document. Do not send your application without confirmation. Do not send your application with unacceptable documentation.

You have until 31 December 2023 to submit your application, and you will receive the same amount whenever you submit the application. You will receive NO GRANT if you submit an incomplete application or an application with the wrong supporting documents.
