TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR EDUCATIONAL GRANT 2024

**This grant is provided at the discretion of the Trustees of the
Stoke Mandeville and Other Parishes Charity**

Who can apply for this grant

This grant is available to students that have resided in the parishes of Stoke Mandeville or Great or Little Hampden for 2 or more years as at 1 September 2024.

Who can NOT apply for this grant

This grant is only available to students continuing in further education at college or university following completion of their compulsory secondary school examinations. Applications from students studying at secondary school for GCSE's, AS and A-levels, or equivalent exams will not be considered under this application process

What is this grant for

This grant is intended to assist with the costs of purchasing books and equipment necessary to continuing studies in further education and will not be sufficient to cover tuition fees or maintenance.

How to apply for this grant

Complete this application form and send it to the Accounts & Administration provider at the address on the form, **with the correct supporting documentation.**

When to apply for this grant

Applications must be received by the Accounts and Administration provider by midnight, 31 December 2024.

What happens next

Applicants meeting the required eligibility criteria, who have provided a legible application form completed and correct, and who have included appropriate supporting documentation, will receive their grant as soon as their application has been processed.

How much is the grant

The 2024/2025 grant will be £400 for University students and £300 for college and “Other” students.

Sending your supporting documents

You are required to send documentation that confirms your attendance specifically for the academic year you are applying for. **Application forms without this confirmation will be rejected.**

If no letter of confirmation from your college or university is automatically sent to you, you must ask your registrar, tutor or school administrator for one.

If you do not have appropriate confirmation before you begin university or college, PLEASE WAIT and ask the school for the correct document.

Do not send your application without confirmation. Do not send your application with unacceptable documentation.

You have until 31 December 2024 to submit your application, and you will receive the same amount whenever you submit the application. You will receive NO GRANT if you submit an incomplete application or an application with the wrong supporting documents.

What is the WRONG supporting documents

- Ø Offer letters
- Ø Student finance paperwork
- Ø Exam results from prior year exams
- Ø Offer letters / confirmation from a prior year
- Ø Photographs of your student ID
- Ø **Screenshots / photos of anything! (We cannot print these out)**
